Are you seeking Board Certification in Behavior Analysis?

Cutting-Edge Course Instruction

Beginning March 31, 2007 Florida Institute of Technology will offer BEHP 5000 – the first course of the Behavior Analyst Certification Board® pre-approved course sequence.* Each class of the course sequence will be broadcast live, alternatively from studios located at Florida Tech and Florida Gulf Coast University. Students will communicate with course developer Dr. Martinez-Diaz in real-time. Each site will have a facilitator. Testing – with the exception of the final exam – will be done online. Class sessions will be available on a course Web site for review; and to make up missed class sessions.

Course Instructor

Nationally recognized behavior analysis professor and lecturer, Jose Martinez-Diaz, Ph.D., BCBA, associate professor and chair, Behavior Analysis Graduate Program, Florida Institute of Technology, will be the instructor for BEHP 5000–Concepts & Principles of Behavior Analysis. He is also the president of ABA Technologies, Inc. Dr. Martinez-Diaz is a member of the Board of Directors of the Behavior Analyst Certification Board and has received several awards for his contributions to the field. Dr. Martinez-Diaz started conducting workshops to prepare individuals for certification in behavior analysis in 1989, and has conducted these workshops in numerous states. His mock certification examinations are administered by several universities as part of their curriculum.
